#### **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

We are encouraged by your interest in Parkview Christian School. These are the steps to follow in submitting your application for admission.

- <u>Step 1:</u> Submit all parts of the completed application together with the required fees. A completed application will include these items:
  - Application / Testing Fee \$125.00
  - Listen to enclosed CD of the Parkview Philosophy of Education, required listening for all prospective parents.
  - Read <u>For the Children's Sake</u> by Susan Schaeffer Macaulay which is available on Amazon or for \$5.00 in our school office. We also ask that you learn more about our overall philosophy from the Principal and Pastor of our parent school, Perimeter Christian. You can listen to them on CD, which we have available in our school office or by watching the video on Vimeo: https://vimeo.com/142641989.
  - Photocopy of most recent report card and previous year's achievement test scores
  - Photocopy of any special testing that has been done with your student
- <u>Step 2:</u> Give the Church Reference form to your pastor or a staff member of your church who knows your family well. This reference should be mailed directly to PCS.
- <u>Step 3:</u> Give the Family Reference forms to two Christian adults *(non-family members)* who know your family well. These reference forms should be completed by someone who is not related to your family and then mailed directly to PCS.
- Step 4: Read the Biblical Beliefs form. If you are in agreement with these stated beliefs, please sign the form and return it with your student application directly to PCS.
- <u>Step 5:</u> Give the Request for Records and Student Reference form to the student's school. The school is to attach a photocopy of school records and health records. The school should return these directly to PCS. **If** your child has not yet attended school, the Student Reference form may be given to a Sunday School teacher.
- <u>Step 6:</u> When all materials have been received by the <u>Director of Admissions</u> (completed application, fees, school records, health records, reference forms, Biblical beliefs form and test results), testing will be scheduled for the next available testing date.
- <u>Step 7:</u> When testing has been completed and both parents have listened to the Philosophy CD and read <u>For the</u> Children's Sake, your family admission interview with two School Board members will be arranged.

NOTE: Reference forms should be submitted directly to PCS by fax, scanned copy, email, or mail. Photo pictures of reference forms may not be accepted due to readability.
