

PCS Reopening Plan Addendum to "Health and Safety Precautions 2021-22"

This is a living document and subject to change

Parkview Christian School is enacting a six-point hybrid model to ensure a safe reopening for in-person instruction to begin our 29th year. As a smaller school with fewer students, PCS is able to provide a closely-monitored classroom environment with ample time out of doors. We are continually monitoring Covid information; should new developments occur, we will adjust our protocol to ensure that students receive a high quality education in a protected environment.

1. ILLNESS

Avoid close contact with people who are sick. Home is the best first defense.

- Staff and students who are unwell must stay home.
- If anyone in your household or anyone that you or your child have been in close contact with receives a positive test result for COVID-19, your child may not come to school. There will be a 10-day waiting period before they may return. If there is a positive COVID-19 test, please communicate that to the **School Leadership Team (SLT)** as soon as possible so that we can make arrangements to continue learning at home if necessary. You can email the SLT at transitionteam@parkviewchristian.com or leave a message with the school office.
- If your child develops a fever during the school day, we will contact you immediately to come and get your child.
- We will follow CDC recommendations for reentry to school for any student who tests positive for COVID-19.

2. TEMPERATURE CHECK

Please check your child's temperature each morning before bringing them to school, and do not send them to school if their temperature is 100.4 degrees or higher, per CDC guidelines.

3. MASKS

As of this printing, students and staff will wear masks during morning/afternoon carpool, large gatherings without ample social distancing in place, and in special circumstances determined by administration.

- School visitors who are not part of the school community will be required to wear a mask.
- Masks will be provided by parents/guardians.
- Students are required to wear masks when entering the building in the morning, when waiting for the afternoon carpool, and when directed by their teacher throughout the day.
- Students may also wear masks during class if that is their parents' preference.

4. HAND HYGIENE

Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.

- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least twenty seconds.
- Students will have additional opportunities for hand washing and use of hand sanitizer throughout the day.

5. ADDITIONAL CLASSROOM SANITIZATION

Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

- Shared spaces and doorknobs will be sanitized throughout the day.
- Classrooms will be sanitized (desks, tables, etc.) at the end of each day.

6. SOCIAL DISTANCING

We will maintain social distancing guidelines where possible.

- Student desks will face forward in all classrooms or be spaced apart as much as possible.
- Student seats will be spaced apart during chapel and at other events, as needed, to maintain full social distancing guidelines.
