^{**}Re-enrollment fees may be divided into two equal payments:

- Re-enrollment Fees can be paid through FACTS or by check.
- The first payment due upon re-enrollment.
- The second payment, a post-dated check for April 11, 2022, at the time of re-enrollment.

Payments not received by stated due date will result in a delay in the admissions process or forfeiture of enrollment priority. School attendance cannot begin until all fees are paid and tuition payments are current.

Admissions Policy and Procedure for new applicants:

- Priority is given to members of Parkview Church for new family applicants
- Application submitted with signed Biblical Beliefs form after reading "The Value of Charlotte
 Mason's Work for Today" by Susan Macaulay and listening online to Perimeter School's explanation
 of Charlotte Mason's Philosophy of Education.
- Church, Family, Student References, and previous school records (if applicable) received and reviewed.
- Admissions testing
- Family interview scheduled once testing is completed
- Interview conducted with parents by two School Board members
- Family notified of status by phone.
