Admissions Policy and Procedure for new applicants:

- Application is submitted with signed Biblical Beliefs form after reading "The Value of Charlotte
 Mason's Work for Today" by Susan Schaeffer Macaulay and listening to Perimeter School's
 explanation of Charlotte Mason's Philosophy of Education. Both can be found under the Admissions
 tab on our website, parkviewchristian.com.
- Church, Family, & Student References and previous school records (if applicable) are received and reviewed.
- Admissions testing is completed.
- A family interview with parents will be conducted by two School Board members and scheduled after testing is completed.
- The family will be notified of admission status by phone.
