

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

We are encouraged by your interest in Parkview Christian School. These are the steps to follow in submitting your application for admission.

- Step 1: Submit all parts of the completed application together with the required fees. A completed application will include these items:
 - Application /Testing Fee \$250.00 paid on our website (Admissions tab and click "Pay Application Fee").
 - Read "Charlotte Mason's Work for Today" by Susan Schaeffer Macaulay, available on our website by clicking the "Apply" tab on the homepage.
 - We also ask that you learn more about our overall philosophy from the Principal and Pastor of our parent school, Perimeter Christian. You can watch the video on Vimeo: https://vimeo.com/142641989
 - Photocopy of your child's most recent report card and previous year's achievement test scores
 - Photocopy of any special testing administered to your child
- <u>Step 2:</u> Give the Church Reference form to your pastor or a staff member of your church who knows your family well. This reference should be mailed directly to PCS.
- Step 3: Give the Friend Reference forms to two Christian adults (non-family members) who know your family well. These reference forms should be completed by someone who is not related to your family and then mailed directly to PCS.
- <u>Step 4:</u> Read the Biblical Beliefs form. If you are in agreement with these stated beliefs, please sign the form and return it with your student application directly to PCS.
- Step 5: Give the Request for Records and Student Reference form to your child's school. The school is to attach a photocopy of school records (including testing) and health records. The school should return these directly to PCS. If your child has not yet attended school, the Student Reference form may be given to a Sunday School teacher.
- Step 6: When all materials have been received by the Director of Admissions (completed application, fees, school records including testing, health records which include forms 3231 and 3300, copy of birth certificate, reference forms, Biblical beliefs form and test results), testing will be scheduled for your child.
- <u>Step 7:</u> When testing has been completed and both parents have watched the philosophy video and read "Charlotte Mason's Work for Today," your family admission interview with two School Board members will be arranged.

NOTE: Reference forms should be submitted directly to PCS by email or mail. *Photo pictures of reference forms may not be accepted due to readability issues.

- 4. We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature, and that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone we are saved, not through works we may do (John 3:16-19 and 5:25, Romans 3:23 and 5:8-9, Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:5).
- 5. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; that they are saved unto the resurrection of life, and that they are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29)
- 6. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9, I Corinthians 12:12-13, Galatians 3:26-28).
- 7. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Romans 8:13-14, I Corinthians 3:16 and 6:19-20, Ephesians 4:30 and 5:18).
- 8. We believe that God created man in His own image, and therefore all life is sacred. We believe that abortion is sinful and is destructive not only for the child but for the mother as well (Psalm 139:14-16).
